

**Los Angeles Net
Net Control Station Script
Revised Jan 13 2014**

<5 min before net starts>

The Los Angeles Traffic Net will begin at 8:30 pm. Any station needing to make a call using this repeater is invited to do so now. This is <your call>, Net Control.

<at net start time – check if repeater is in use>

Calling all amateurs on the Papa System. This is <your name>, <your call>, Net Control for tonight's session of the National Traffic System Los Angeles Net. All licensed amateurs are invited to participate.

This is a directed net. Emergency or priority traffic may break in at any time & the net will stand by. Is there any emergency or priority traffic? <pause>

Are there any official announcements or bulletins <pause>

Is a representative from the RN6 net present <pause for RN6 liaison station>

<when checking in stations, note their call sign, first name & location, any traffic they are listing & whether they will take traffic>

Are there any representatives from the Orange Section?

Are there any representatives from other nets?

<pause for other liaison stations – continue until no more heard>

Any stations wishing to list traffic please give your callsign phonetically & give your name & location. After you key your mic, please pause briefly before speaking, to give the linked repeaters time to activate. This is <your call>, Net Control.

<check stations in, ask them to list traffic – continue until no more heard – make traffic list>

<read traffic list not already assigned>

We will now take check-ins from any other stations or visitors. If you are able to help with any of the listed traffic, please advise Net Control.

<take check-ins, noting spoken-for traffic – continue until no more heard>

<direct stations to pass traffic – move traffic involving liaison stations first & then excuse the liaison stations – if there is not traffic to or from a liaison station, excuse them right away. When possible move stations off frequency to pass their traffic. Direct the receiving station to call the sending station, identifying what traffic is to be passed. Remember to identify when you pass off control.>

<after all traffic has been passed ...>

Do we have any late check-ins, or anyone with questions or comments for the net, before we close?

<handle late check-ins, questions or comments>
